Mahamudra Meditation: Ground, Path and Fruition

Born in Tibet to a nomadic family, Lama Dudjom Dorje was chosen by His Holiness the 16th Gyalwang Karmapa to teach in America after training for fifteen years in Buddhist philosophy, history, and scriptures at Sanskrit University, Varanasi, India, and completing the three-year, three-month retreat in India under the guidance of Kalu Rinpoche and other Kagyu masters. He serves as the resident lama at the Dallas Karma Thegsum Chöling, and is a frequent visitor to the Albuquerque KTC.

Learn about the Mahamudra form of meditation unique to the Karma Kagyu lineage. Lama Dudjom Dorjee explains what makes it so distinctive, and explores the Ground, Path and Fruition Mahamudra.
